Memo Dutch Silk Road Art Exhibition in the Netherlands 2019

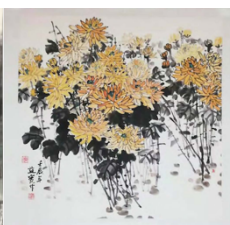

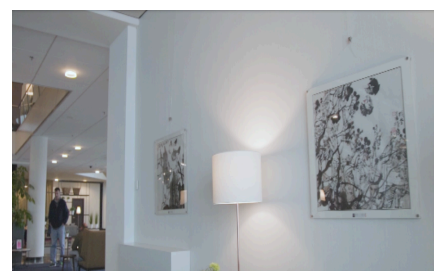
